No trophy will be presented for Primary. > The SOBHD scoring system will be used for aggregate awards: 88, 56, 38, 25, 16, 10. No aggregate awards will be presented for Primar > Premier 16 & Over prizes: 1st-\$25, 2nd-\$20, 3rd-\$15, 4th-\$10, 5th-\$10. These dancers may purchase medals for \$3/medal.					
8.	Performance Pas de Basques is for performance only. It is open to dancers under 7 years of age, who have not competed previously and are not competing in any of events 1 through 4. There is no charge for this event and no awards will be given .
