

- 1. Opening date for entries Payment received online or in mail NO EARLIER THAN 12:01am (Central Standard Time) May 6th, 2016. Entries postmarked before this date will incur a 2-week hold. Closing date for entries - Payment received online or mail postmarked no later than ll:59pm (CST) June 20th, 2016. Entries postmarked after this date will incur a \$25.00 per dancer late penalty in addition to entry fees and will not be in the Souvenir Program. Entries with NSF cheques will be held until payment is cleared. NSF cheques will incur an additional \$45.00 charge. No changes/entries after June 29th, 2016. No field entries accepted. - 3. All dancers must present their SOBHD card at registration in order to compete.
- 4. Entry Fees are \$6.00 for each event plus \$1.00 provincial surcharge (per dancer). No post-dated cheques. Cheques or money orders should be made payable to:

- 5. No medals to be worn during the competition.
- 6. All dancers are requested to stay near the platform in case of a
- 7. Events may not be danced as they appear in the program.
- 8. Dancers must be in suitable costume to receive an award.
- 9. Judges decisions are final. Objections can be made in writing, accompanied by a \$25.00 handling fee, to the dance coordinator within 30 minutes of the event.
- 10. All SOBHD rules apply to the MHG competition.
- 11. First to enter, last to dance. Competitors must fill in for reels, according to their competition number. Dancers who refuse will be disqualified.
- 12. Premier Special Event 50th Annual Manitoba Highland Gathering Cakewalk 4 Steps (1st, 2nd, 4th, 9th) Enter as a team with partner's name - \$15.00 per team. Prizes - 1st - \$100, 2nd - \$75 and 3rd - \$50.
- 13. Prize money, if desired will be awarded in lieu of medals for Premier Dancers 18 and over as follows: \$60, \$45, \$35, \$25, \$20, \$10. Trophies will be awarded in all classes, except primary. Medals and trophies for morning events will be handed out prior to PM events. Medals and trophies for afternoon events will be awarded after all dancing events.
- 14. The competition committee reserves the right to combine, divide or delete classes, depending on entries.
- 15. Judges are qualified members of the SOBHD judges Panel.
