- Broadswords will be judged as a team.
- Broadswords Special will be danced between the Premier Challenge and the Premier Nationals.
- Classes will be split into age categories based on number of entries. Four-Person teams will be drawn once entries have closed.
- Teams (by age category) will be drawn randomly and posted the day of the competition.
- In the event of insufficient dancers for the final set of Broadswords in each class, fill-ins will be used from dancers who have entered first within each age category.
- Dancers who enter first may have more than one opportunity to compete for prizes.
- Set steps will be required.

- \$400 cash prize will be awarded to first place team in each age group.

The Rules: Please read carefully:

- 1. All dancing events are governed by the rules and regulations of the Royal Scottish Official Board of Highland Dancing (RSOBHD) and ScotDance Canada.
- 2. This event may be cancelled at any time up to, and including on or during the date of competition, dependent upon public health concerns.
- 3. The decision of the judge(s) is final.
- 4. With the exception of the competition committee, communication with the judges during the event is strictly prohibited.
- 5. All competitors must be registered with the RSOBHD or RSOBHD subsidiary body (such as ScotDance Canada) in order to compete. All competitors must present current RSOBHD registration card prior to receiving awards. Dancers will be required to pay \$10.00 if they do not present their RSOBHD dance card
- 6. **STATUS CHANGES** Contact our CHDA Registrar via e-mail at. chdaregistrar@gmail.com Deadline for acceptance of status changes is Saturday, May 25th, 2024. No status changes will be accepted the day of the competition.
- 7. There will be **NO ENTRY FEE REFUNDS** for any reason.

- 8. The Competition Committee reserves the right to combine, split or delete classes at the close of entries.
- 9. Dancers will compete in inverse order of entry. First to enter is last to dance.
- 10. Premier dancers may choose to enter the Premier Challenge or Premier Nationals, NOT both.
