Competition Regulations

- 1) NO Field entries. Late fees will be implemented after the closing date of April 10th, 2015. Refunds will only be given at the discretion of the competition committee.
- 2) Saskatchewan dancers: Local association number is required to be eligible for the subsidized competition fee of \$6 per dance. Saskatchewan dancers who are not members of a local association must pay \$12 per dance.
- 3) **SOBHD rules govern the competition.** Dancers will compete in their own age groups only. Proof of age must be shown if requested. Competitors may enter only in events to which his/her age applies and in the correct classification (e.g. Beginner). Please refer to the SOBHD rules.
- 4) Competitors must have a **SOBHD card**. All dancers must present their card prior to dancing. If no card is presented, there will be a \$5 penalty fee and awards (including stamping of card) will be withheld until the card is present to the competition chair.
- 5) Classes will be divided after the closing date for entries at the discretion of the Competition Chairperson. Three competitors constitute a class, however, should there be a single entry where classes cannot be combined, the competitor will be judged. Premier's 7 & under 12 years of age dance cut steps.
- 6) All status changes must be sent or phoned immediately to the Competition Chairperson. (See contact info above)
- 7) **COMPETITORS:** must be suitably attired; must be on hand to dance when their event is called or forfeit the right to dance in that event; last to enter – first to dance; must not wear or display medals until after the competition; must be in **FULL COSTUME** to receive awards.
- 8) Communication with a judge concerning a competitor will result in disqualification of that competitor. Any protests must be in writing and handed to the Competition Chairperson prior to the end of the competition and accompanied by a protest fee of \$15.00. **Decision of the Judges will be final.**
- 9) Flash cameras are not permitted during the competition.
- 10) The competition chair reserves the right to cancel the competition if there are less than 60 entries or if there are not enough volunteers to run the competition.
- 11) **AWARDS**-will be half + 1 the number of dancers dancing, to a maximum of six placings. Dancers must remain in full costume, including dance shoes, for presentation of awards.
The scoring system of the S.O.B.H.D. will be in effect:
88, 56, 38, 25, 16, 10.

Medals & trophies will be awarded. There will be no trophy for the Primary Class.
