RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. All events sanctioned and conducted by the rules and regulations of the SOBHD.
2. Age is determined as of the day of the event
3. **Championship:** Computer Draws for each dance. Entries for the Championship must be received online between April 1 and May 18, 2016.
4. All Dancers must dance the 2016 Championship steps set forth by the SOBHD.
5. **Premiership:** All dancers must dance the 2016 Set Premiership Steps. Set Steps are set forth by the SOBHD
6. Committee reserves the right to combine or split classes.
7. Age classes will be determined upon receipt of entries for Pre-Premier and Premiership.
8. Dancers will dance in reverse order of receipt of entry (i.e. first to enter, last to dance). The order of the Championship will be determined by a draw.
9. Protests must be made in writing; signed and submitted to the competition secretary by the end of the competition day and must be accompanied by a \$30.00 fee, refundable if sustained.
10. All category changes must be emailed to Leah Sutton-Kowles at leahsutton@accesscomm.ca before May 18, 2016.
11. All competitors must present current SOBHD registration card before receiving their awards. Awards will be held and a \$5.00 fee applied to any dancer without a current SOBHD card.
12. Late Entries will be accepted until May 18, 2016 for the double the fee.
13. There will **NO** entry fee refunds.
14. No phone or email entries accepted.
15. Dancers filing in for the Reel must dance entire dance.
16. Medals and trophies will be awarded for pre-premier. No trophy for the Primary class. The scoring system for the SOBHD will be in effect: 88, 56, 38, 25, 16, 10. Overall awards will be given to the top 6 dancers for the Championship and Premiership.
17. In the case of a tie, SOBHD rules will govern. Awards will be given out for half of the number of dancers dancing (rounded up), to a maximum of six placings.
18. Ceilidh Surprise Dancer of the games will be awarded to the dancer in each competitive category (Beginner, Novice, and Intermediate) with the highest aggregate points over all dances between the 2 days of events. As per SOBHD rules, age groups must have a minimum of 6 competitors on the day of the competition to be eligible for an overall trophy. Also, as per SOBHD rules, if there are less than 6 competitors in any individual dance then points gained in that dance will not be included in the total aggregate points for the overall award.
19. WA WA Shriners Championship Dancer of the day/Mary Sutton Premiership Dancer of the Day will be awarded to the Championship/Premiership dancer with the highest overall points.
