Lord Caithness is the Honourary Clan Chieftain of the 53<sup>rd</sup> Annual Manitoba Highland Gathering. He will officiate at the Opening Ceremonies and at the Sinclair Clan Tent.**

### Competition Rules

1. Opening date for entries - All registrations will be done online at [www.manitobahighlandgathering.org](http://www.manitobahighlandgathering.org). Registration opens May 17, 2019 at 6 p.m. Registration closes June 12, 2019 at 11:59 pm. Late entries will be accepted for an additional fee of \$25, up until June 18, 2019 at 11:59 p.m. Late entries will not appear in the commemorative program. No field entries.
2. Notify Alana Goudie at [boomchain@mts.net](mailto:boomchain@mts.net) of any change in classification or to add dances, at least two days prior to the event.
3. All dancers must present their SOBHD card at registration in order to compete.
4. Entry Fees are \$7.00 for each event - plus \$1.00 provincial surcharge (per dancer). Premier Special Event, Duet Choreography-\$15.00 per team.
5. Dancers must fill-in for Reels as requested.
6. Dancers must be in suitable costume to receive an award.
7. Judges decisions are final. Objections can be made in writing, accompanied by a \$25.00 handling fee, to the dance coordinator within 30 minutes of the event.
8. All dancing events are governed by SOBHD rules.
9. First to enter, last to dance. Dancers not present when their class is called will only be permitted to dance out of order at the discretion of the technical advisor(s).
10. Prize money, if desired will be awarded in lieu of medals for oldest Premier class will be awarded: \$60, \$45, \$35, \$25, \$20, \$10. Trophies will be awarded in all classes, except primary.
11. All Highland events will be held in the morning including all Primary & Demonstration Pas-de-Basques. Primary awards will be presented following the morning events. National and Duet Choreography special event will be held in the afternoon. Presentation of all awards, excluding Primary will be presented following the afternoon events.
12. The competition committee reserves the right to combine, divide or delete classes, depending on entries.
13. Technical Advisor – Gaelyn McGregor
14. Refunds with medical certificate only.
15. Demonstration Pas-de-Basques: No entry fees, cannot enter any other event. All dancers receive a gift. Please submit an entry to determine numbers.
16. Premier Special Event - Duet Choreography: Open to all Premier Dancers. Dancers enter as a team and may only enter once. Names and ages of both dancers must appear on the entry form. Complete dance with entrance and exit may not exceed 3 minutes. Music must be provided to registration desk upon registering at 9:30 a.m.

**WAIVER:** *I am aware that participating in the Manitoba Highland Gathering (the "Event") involves the potential for risks, dangers and hazards, including but not limited to: (a) injury to myself / my child as a result of the physical nature of dance competition and performance; and (b) the taking and/or release of unauthorized photographs, video and/or other recordings of myself and/or my child, notwithstanding efforts to enforce Event policies.*
