When signing-up, we ask our volunteers to begin thinking about the role you may wish to play in support of the 2022 ScotDance National Championship. As we prepare to host this event, we hope our volunteers can gain experience and feel confident in performing their duties. We will all be serving as Saskatchewan ambassadors. This means, we are asking volunteers to consider signing up for the same volunteer duties today as they may perform in 2022. Or try out different duties, see what you like and sign-up accordingly as we move forward.

Competition Information

1. **SOBHD rules** govern the competition. Dancers will compete in their own age groups only. Proof of age must be shown if requested.
2. **SOBHD Card:** Competitors must have a ScotDance/SOBHD Card. All dancers must present their ScotDance card prior to dancing. No card at the competition will result in a \$5.00 penalty fee and awards (including stamping of card) will be withheld until card is presented to competition chair, for up to a maximum of 10 days. At which time the competitor's name and number will be passed to the SOBHD registration unit, who may advise all organizers not to accept an entry from the competitor until such matters are satisfactorily cleared up.
3. **Dancers must comply with SOBHD conduct.** Failure to do so will result in the dancer being reported to the SOBHD.
4. **Entries:** Enter online at www.eventry.net/rhda. Entries accepted no earlier than 7:00 a.m. (CST) Monday September 30, 2019 until 11:59 p.m. on Monday October 21, 2019. Late fee will apply after this time. No entries accepted after 11:59 p.m. Sunday October 27, 2019.
5. **Entry Fee:** All Dancers with a valid membership in their Local Saskatchewan Highland Dancing Association will pay \$6/dance. All other dancers will pay \$12/dance. Dancers may be required to provide proof of membership in their local association. Surcharges of \$6 per dancer will apply (SHD - \$5, SDCCS Provincial Surcharge - \$1). A late fee of \$25 per family will be applied for late entries. No refunds will be given. Payments accepted via PayPal.
6. **Status Changes:** Must be emailed to rhdacompetition@gmail.com no later than October 27, 2019. NO CHANGES will be allowed on competition day.
7. **Dancers** must be on hand to dance in numerical sequence, or forfeit right to dance in that event. Last to enter, first to dance. Classes to be combined, divided or canceled at discretion of competition chair, depending on the entries received. Three competitors constitute a class; however, should there be a single entry where classes cannot be combined, the competitor will be judged.
8. **Awards:** Dancers must remain in full costume, including dance shoes, for presentation of awards.
 - To a minimum of half the number of dancers dancing, to a maximum of six placings.
 - The SOBHD scoring system will be used for aggregate awards: 137, 91, 71, 53, 37, 23. No aggregate awards will be presented for Primary.
 - Premier 16 & Over prizes: 1st-\$25, 2nd-\$20, 3rd-\$15, 4th-\$10, 5th-\$10, 6th-\$10. These dancers may purchase medals for \$3/medal.
 - Cash prizes for the premier choreography category.
9. **Performance Pas de Basques** are for performance only. They are open to dancers under 7 years of age, who have not competed previously and are not competing in any of events 1 through 4. There is no charge for this event and no awards will be given.
10. **Choreography** performances must be a maximum of three minutes, including entrances and exits. Music and costumes must have a Scottish/Celtic theme. Please email a digital copy of the music to rhdacompetition@gmail.com at the time of registration, and no later than October 23, 2019. Premier dancers only.
11. **The Organizing Committee** reserves the right to cancel the competition if there are less than 60 entries.
12. **The decision of the judge is final.** Protests must be in writing and handed to the Competition Chairperson on the day of the competition, accompanied by a \$15 fee which will be refunded if sustained.
13. **Flash cameras are not allowed during competition.**
14. **Your email receipt** from Eventry.com will serve as your confirmation.
