Ohio Valley Branch Virtual Competition Rules

- 1. All sanctioned contests will accumulate points for both EUSPBA season point totals as well as Ohio Valley Branch Champion Supreme (Members of the Ohio Valley Branch Only)
- 2. All decisions by judges, stewards and other festival officials are final.
- 3. This a EUSPBA Sanctioned Event and all rules and regulations concerning competition apply unless otherwise stated
- 4. Each event must be submitted in a separate video
- 5. Each event video must be made in one complete take (no editing, or splicing)
- 6. The competitor must clearly state his/her name, grade, contest, competitor number, tune, current date and time at the beginning of the video
- 7. Competitors will not be required to be in Highland dress or march
- 8. All other rules applicable to EUSPBA contests (i.e. sanctioning, result reporting etc.) remain in effect
- 9. Entry Deadline is July 6, 2020
- 10. Your videos must be not be recorded before July 10, 2020 @ 8 AM.
- 11. All video's must be uploaded by July 13, 2020 @ 8:00 AM
- 12. Your video should show most or all of your body, including your head. Your video must be lighted properly so your face and hands can be clearly seen.
- 13. Videos with poor lighting or sound (backlighting, face and hands not clearly visible, distorted sound, etc.) may be not be accepted.
- 14. Upload your video to YouTube and set it to Public or Unlisted but not private.
- 15. Piobaireachd events: You must email us the sheet music for your tune if your setting is not from the Kilberry or Piobaireachd Society books.
- 16. Playing on a snare drum is encouraged but not required. You may play on a drum pad or table top. New Rule: For virtual solo tenor and bass drumming contests only, competitors are permitted to use either a drum, a drum pad, or a hard surface.
- 17. For drumming events, no piper is needed. You have the choice to play unaccompanied, with a live piper, or with a recording of a piper. Rule New Rule For all virtual solo drumming contests, accompaniment is required. If the roll off command is not audible on the recorded accompaniment used, it is permissible for the competitor to listen to the first roll off and only play the second roll of the roll off.
- 18. If you choose to use a recording of a piper, the recording may be of a piper playing the Highland bagpipes, Electronic pipes, or practice chanter.
- 19. Copy and paste the link into a Word document (be sure it's a hyperlink so the judges can click on it)
- 20. Save the word document using the format: name, competitor number, grade event, 2020OVV
- 21. Email the word document to euspbaovbranch@gmail.com
- 22. We will make sure everything is in order for the judges during the week
- 23. Judges will review the videos on July 18^{th.}
- 24. Results will be posted on the Ohio Valley Branch Facebook Page
- 25. Soloists who identify being affiliated with bands will be awarded points. 8 pts for 1st, 5 pts for 2nd, 3 points for 3rd and 4 pts for 4th. The top three band will be awarded Tone ProtectorTM Reed Case donated by bagpipelessons.com
