- 1. The rules and regulations of the S.O.B.H.D. will govern all dancing.
- 2. Age is determined as of the day of each event.
- 3. **Championship:** Computer draws for each dance. All dancers must dance the 2020 Championship steps set forth by the SOBHD.
- 4. **Premiership:** Dancers will dance in order of entry. All dancers must dance 2020 Premiership steps set forth by the SOBHD.
- 5. **Pre-Championship:** Entry is restricted to those who have never won a Pre-Championship or a Championship.
- Premier National: Open to Premier dancers who do not wish to dance the Premiership. Irish Jig is a 4 step for dancers 7 & under 12 years, 5 step for all dancers 12 years and over.
- 30<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Blue Bonnets Challenge: 4 step Blue Bonnets for the 7 & Under 12 class, 6 step Blue Bonnets for 12 & Under 16 Years and 16 Years & Over Classes. Cash prizes will be awarded for all winners.
- 8. Committee reserves the right to combine or split classes.
- 9. Age classes will be determined upon receipt of entries for all dance events.
- 10. Dancers will dance in reverse order of receipt of entry. First to enter, last to dance (except Championship which will be a draw).
- 11. Protests must be made in writing, signed and submitted to the competition secretary by the end of the competition

- 13. Dancers may enter either Pre-Championship or Championship classes, or both.
- 14. Dancers must choose between the Premiership and Premier National competition.
- 15. All competitors must present current SOBHD registration card before receiving their awards. Awards will be held and a \$10.00 fee applied to any dancer without a current SOBHD card.
- 16. Prizes: Cash prizes awarded in the 16 & over Championship, Premier National Competition and Premiership. Medals for all other classes. Cash Prizes will be awarded for all winners in the 30<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Blue Bonnets Challenge. Beginner Special Fling will receive a special prize.
- 17. Absolutely **NO** late entries will be accepted.
- 18. There will be **NO** entry fee refunds.
- 19. Absolutely <u>NO</u> telephone, email, mail or hand delivered entries.
- 20. Dancers filling in for the Reel must dance entire dance.
- 21. Number will be used for both days.
- 22. Dancers must comply with the SOBHD Code of Conduct. Failure to do so will result in the dancer being reported to the SOBHD.
