Competition Information

- 1. **RSOBHD rules** govern the competition. Dancers will compete in their own age groups only. Proof of age must be shown if requested.
- 2. **RSOBHD Card:** Competitors must have a ScotDance/RSOBHD Card with a **2020 sticker**. All dancers must present their ScotDance card prior to dancing. No card at the competition will result in a \$5.00 penalty fee and awards (including stamping of card) will be withheld until card is presented to competition chair, for up to a maximum of 10 days after which the competitor's name and number will be passed to the SOBHD registration unit, who may advise all organizers not to accept an entry from the competitor until such matters are satisfactorily cleared up.
- 3. **Dancers must comply with RSOBHD conduct**. Failure to do so will result in the dancer being reported to the SOBHD.
- 4. **Entries:** Enter online at www.eventry.net/rhda. Entries accepted no earlier than 7:00 a.m. (CST) Monday February 3, 2020 until 11:59 p.m. on Monday February 24, 2020. Late fee will apply after this time. No entries accepted after 11:59 p.m. Monday, March 2, 2020.
- 5. **Entry Fee:** All Dancers with a valid membership in their Local Saskatchewan Highland Dancing Association will pay \$7/dance. All other Saskatchewan dancers will pay \$14/dance. Out of province pay \$7/dance Duo \$25/group Small Group \$40/group Large Group \$40/group. Dancers may be required to provide proof of membership in their local association. Surcharges of \$2 per dancer will apply (SHD \$1, SDCCS Provincial Surcharge \$1). A late fee of \$25 per family will be applied for late entries. No refunds will be given. Payments accepted via PayPal.
- 6. **Status Changes:** Must be emailed to rhdacompetition@gmail.com no later than March 2, 2020. NO CHANGES will be allowed on competition day.
- 7. **Dancers** must be on hand to dance in numerical sequence, or forfeit right to dance in that event. Last to enter, first to dance. Classes to be combined, divided or canceled at discretion of competition chair, depending on the entries received. Three competitors constitute a class; however, should there be a single entry where classes cannot be combined, the competitor will be judged.
- 8. Awards: Dancers must remain in full costume, including dance shoes, for presentation of awards.
 - > To a minimum of half the number of dancers dancing, to a maximum of six placings.
 - > The RSOBHD scoring system will be used for aggregate awards: 137, 91, 71, 53, 37, 23. No aggregate awards will be presented for Primary.
 - > Premier 16 & Over prizes: 1st-\$25, 2nd-\$20, 3rd-\$15, 4th-\$10, 5th-\$10, 6th-\$10. These dancers may purchase medals for \$3/medal.
 - > Cash prizes for Choreographies 1st \$50, 2nd \$40 3rd \$30, 4th \$20, 5th \$10, 6th \$10.
- 9. **Danny Matheson Memorial Trophy** is awarded to the RHDA Premier dancer of the day with the highest aggregate points over all dances (except special dances). Age groups must have a minimum of 6 competitors on the day of competition in order to be eligible for an overall trophy. As per RSOBHD rules, if there are less than 6 competitors in any individual dance then points gained in that dance will not be included in the total aggregate points for the overall award.
- 10. **Joanne Sinclair Memorial Trophy** is awarded to the youngest Beginner class with the highest aggregate points over all dances (except special dances). Age groups must have a minimum of 6 competitors on the day of competition in order to be eligible for an overall trophy. As per RSOBHD rules, if there are less than 6 competitors in any individual dance then points gained in that dance will not be included in the total aggregate points for the overall award.
- 11. **Performance Pas de Basques** are for performance only. They are open to dancers under 7 years of age, who have not competed previously and are not competing in any of events 1 through 4. There is no charge for this event and no awards will be given.
- 12. The Organizing Committee reserves the right to cancel the competition if there are less than 60 entries.
- 13. **The decision of the judge is final**. Protests must be in writing and handed to the Competition Chairperson on the day of the competition, accompanied by a \$15 fee which will be refunded if sustained.
- 14. Flash cameras are not allowed during competition.
- 15. **Your email receipt** from Eventry.com will serve as your confirmation.

- $17.\,\textbf{Choreography Rules}$
 - a. All choreography events will be run under RSOBHD Choreography rules
 - b. Dancers may enter only once in any event (i.e. a dancer may be included in a duo/trio and a small group entry, but may not be included in 2 different small group entries)
 - c. Classes may be divided based on average age according to dancer age on March 7, 2020.
 - d. No Primary dancers. All other levels may enter choreography events. All dancers must present their 2020 RSOBHD Dancer Registration card.

- e. All choreography entries must have a Scottish or Celtic theme/appearance.
- f. All time limits include entrances and exits. Entries going over stated time limits will be disqualified.
- g. **ALL** Choreography entries must submit music electronically to rhdacompetition@gmail.com by March 2, 2020. <u>Music not received by the deadline will be removed from the competition and no refunds will be provided.</u>
- h. Duos: One entry per team of 2 dancers. All dancer names and ages to be submitted with entry. **Time limit: 2 minutes.**
- i. Group Choreography. Open theme as per RSOBHD rules. All dancer names and ages to be submitted with entry. One group per entry. Small Group is 4-7 dancers, Large Group 8 or more dancers. **Time limit: 3 minutes**.
