Championship Rules and Regulation

- 1. Alberta Open Championships are sanctioned and conducted under the rules of the Scottish Official Board of Highland Dancing.
- 2. Entries will only be accepted online. Online entry receipt serves as official confirmation of entry.
- 3. The order to dance will be random draw for the Fling, Sword and Sean Triubhas. The order for the Reel will be first to enter, last to dance.
- 4. Age as of February 22nd, 2020.
- 5. Dancers must perform the 2020 Championship steps.
- 6. Additional adjudicators may be added at the discretion of the Organizing Committee, without any advance public notice.
- 7. The Organizing Committee reserves the right to combine, split or delete/cancel classes according to the entries received.
- 8. All competitors must present their 2020 SOBHD Dancer Registration cards to pick up their numbers and to receive awards. All competitors must remain in costume for all award presentations.

Competition Rules and Regulations

- 1. Competition will be governed by the rules and regulations of the Scottish Official Board of Highland Dancing.
- 2. Age as of February 22, 2020.
- 3. The Organizing Committee reserves the right to combine, split or delete/cancel classes according to the entries received.
- 4. Entries will only be accepted online. Online entry receipt serves as official confirmation of entry.
- 5. All competitors must present their 2020 SOBHD Dancer Registration cards to pick up their numbers and to receive awards. All competitors must remain in costume for all award presentations.
- 6. Prize Money will be awarded to Premier dancers 16 Years & older 1st \$50; 2nd \$40; 3rd \$30; 4th, 5th, 6th - \$20
- 7. All status changes must be reported no later than 6 days prior to the competition. Please send status changes to elayna@campbelldancers.com.
- 8. The judge's decision is final. Any protests must be in writing, signed and handed to the Organizing Committee before the end of the championship or competition day, accompanied by a fee of \$35.00 that will be refunded if the protest is sustained.
- 9. Additional adjudicators may be added at the discretion of the Organizing Committee, without any advance public notice.

Choreography Rules and Regulations

- 1. Only Premier dancers may enter the solo choreography event. All levels may enter the duet or group choreography events.
- 2. Average age determined based on the age of dancer on February 23rd, 2019.
- 3. Solo Choreography: Must be Scottish or Celtic in appearance and theme including costume and music. Time limit: 2 minutes
- 4. Duet Choreography: 2 dancers. Must be Scottish or Celtic in appearance and theme including costume and music. Average age of group determines age category. Time limit: 3 minutes
- 5. Group Choreography: 3 or more dancers. Must be Scottish or Celtic in appearance and theme including costume and music. Average age of group determines age category. Time limit: 3 minutes
- 6. Dancers MAY enter more than one choreography event but only 1 event per form
- 7. All listed times limits above include entrances and exits.
- 8. All dancers must present their 2019 SOBHD Dancer Registration cards at registration.
