General Competition Rules & Regulations

EHDA Alberta Confined National Competition will be held on Saturday, October 23, 2021 at Beaumont Community Centre, 5204—50 Avenue, Beaumont, Alberta

- 1. Age as of October 23, 2021.
- 2. Entries are <u>restricted to residents</u> of the province <u>of Alberta</u> only.
- Entries will be divided into categories after the closing date. The Competition Committee reserves the right to combine, split, or delete/cancel classes or events at their discretion.
- All competitors must present their current 2022 RSOBHD registration cards to receive awards and must remain in costume for all award presentations.
- 5. Prize Money (16 Years & Over) will be awarded as follows: 1st - \$25 2nd - \$20 3rd - \$15 4th - \$10 5th - \$10 6th - \$10 Medal Structure for all classes is 1/2 the number of dancers to a maximum of 6 medals for each dance; for an odd number of dancers in a class, the number of medals is rounded up to the next whole number.
- 6.. No one other than the Competition Committee shall communicate with the judges.
- Solo Choreography maximum length is 2 minutes. Choreography music must be emailed to: melanic.aeberhardt@gmail.com by Monday, October 18th.
- Pre-Premier status changes must be reported prior to the competition, please email : <u>melanie.aeberhardt@gmail.com</u>
- 9. Perpetual trophies are the property of E.H.D.A. and must be returned eleven months after the competition. Winners are responsible for name engraving and care of the trophy. Repairs, other than normal maintenance, will be the responsibility of the dancer or parent/guardian. Any damage should be reported to the competition committee well in advance of the next year's event.
- Protests must be in writing, signed and handed to the Competition Committee before the end of the competition with a \$25.00 fee. This fee is refundable if the protest is sustained.
- 11. All fees are non-refundable.
- 12. Dancers and parents should take precautions with respect to the transmission of COVID at this event. Social dis -tancing and masking in public areas are recommended. Hand sanitizers will be available for participants. Please do not congregate in the change room. Any additional COVID protocols will be emailed to competitors prior to the event.
