These events will be held in compliance with all current federal and provincial health and safety orders as well as facility requirements for COVID-19. Our goal is to allow our dancers to compete in a safe, calm, inclusive and positive environment. It is possible that these orders may change between the release of this entry and the competition date; requirements will be updated before the competition as necessary. We appreciate unexpected situations could arise on the day that may require action to protect our dancers, judges, pipers, volunteers, and other participants.

Please be respectful of all requirements and request or you will be escorted from the facility and no refund will be given.

BC VACCINE CARD

As per current BC Health Guidelines and Tournament Capital Centre Requirements, everyone entering our venue aged 12 years and older (dancers, parents/guardians, teachers, volunteers, judges, pipers, etc.) will need to provide proof of vaccination via BC Vaccine Card and a Government issued photo ID (ID only required for anyone aged 19 and over). Please ensure that you and your dancer aged 12 and over (born in or before 2009) will be fully vaccinated at least 2 weeks prior to November 6, 2021.

IHDA FALL COMPETITION RULES AND REGULATIONS:

1. All dancing events are governed by the rules and regulations of the Royal Scottish Official Board of Highland Dancing (RSOBHD) and ScotDance Canada.
2. This event may be cancelled at any time up to, and including on or during the date of competition, dependent upon public health concerns.
3. Ages as of competition date.
4. Competitors will dance in reverse order of registration (first to enter is last to dance).
5. Online entries will be accepted from 8:00am October 9, 2021, through 11:59pm October 29, 2021.
6. No late entries will be accepted.
7. There will be NO entry fee refunds. If admittance to the event is refused based upon good health declaration, fees will be refunded except for an administration fee of \$5.00 per family.
8. Absolutely NO mail, telephone, email, or hand delivered entries.
9. Dancers must be a resident of British Columbia.
10. Competition Committee reserves the right to combine or split classes.
11. The decision of the judge(s) is final.
12. Protests must be made in writing, signed and submitted to the competition secretary by the end of the competition day and must be accompanied by a \$35.00 fee, refundable if sustained.
13. All category changes must be emailed to: ihda.competitions@gmail.com before November 1, 2021.
14. All competitors must present current RSOBHD registration card before receiving their number. Awards will be held, and a \$10.00 fee applied for any dancer without a current RSOBHD card.
15. There will be no costume changes, dancers must arrive at the competition venue prepared to compete. Change Room facilities will not be available and changing in washroom facilities will not be accepted.
16. Dancers must be dressed appropriately at all times.
17. All competitors must remain in costume for award presentations.
18. Prizes: ****Cash Prizes awarded in the 16 & Over Premier Classes (1st \$35, 2nd \$30, 3rd \$25, 4th \$20, 5th \$15, 6th \$10)** and medals in all other classes. A special award will be given for the Special Fling in Beginner and Novice.
19. * Special Fling does not count towards the aggregate. It is a standard 4 step Fling that is awarded a special prize.
20. Dancers and parents must respect the ScotDance Canada Risk Management Guidelines, Local Health Authority directives, and the RSOBHD Code of Ethics.

RULES FOR ATTENDING SCOTDANCE CANADA SANCTIONED COMPETITIONS:

1. On the competition day, entry into the competition will be allowed **ONLY** after QR code or contract tracing sheet has been signed and declaration of good health has been provided.
2. On the day of the competition, if you or any of your household members are feeling unwell, experiencing COVID-like symptoms, has been diagnosed with COVID-19, or have been asked by Public Health to self-isolate, **please stay home** and advise ihda.competitions@gmail.com of your situation.
3. If you test positive for COVID-19 following the event, **you must notify the competition organizer** by emailing ihda.competitions@gmail.com.
4. **Masks MUST be worn by all entering the facility if there is a provincial government mask mandate order in effect at the time.** If a provincial government mask mandate order is not in effect at the time, wearing of masks is strongly encouraged for the safety of all attending. **Please bring your own mask!**
 - a. Dancers may choose to remove their mask prior to going on stage for each dance. A bag will be provided for each dancer's mask if they choose to remove it while competing.
5. **Physical Distancing is strongly encouraged at all times** while within the facility.
6. Only one parent/guardian is allowed in the facility with their dancer(s) if crowd size capacity requirements are in effect.
7. All competitors and their parents/guardians are required to exit the facility once their competition events are completed. An exception is where a parent/guardian may be volunteering, and even then, they must exit once their duties have been completed (exiting facility requirements are dependent upon crowd size capacity restrictions in effect).
8. There will be **no costume changes** and no space provided for costume changes at this time. Dancers are to arrive in costume prepared to dance, hair done, and make-up applied. Please bring safety pins to affix number to dance costume.
9. No garment bags or personal foam mats will be allowed within the facility when crowd size capacity restrictions are in place. Please leave unnecessary items in your vehicle.
10. If crowd size capacity restrictions are in place, in order to facilitate the unique situation faced when organizing this event, dancers will be called to the marshalling (line-up) area in small groups almost immediately prior to competing. Dancers who do not arrive when called may forfeit their opportunity to compete for that event.
11. If crowd size capacity restrictions are in place, it is a recommendation for the results to be announced following each dance category, and awards will be given out as competitors exit the facility at the end of their competition time.
12. Washroom facilities will have limited occupancy depending on number of cubicles while maintaining the facilities' physical distancing requirements. Please limit use as much as is possible.

COMPETITION WAIVER TO BE CONFIRMED WITH ONLINE ENTRY:

I am aware that participating in the IHDA Fall Competition Event involves the potential for risks, dangers, and hazards, including but not limited to:

- (a) injury to myself / my child as a result of the physical nature of dance competition and performance; and
- (b) the taking and/or release of unauthorized photographs, video and/or other recordings of myself and/or my child, notwithstanding efforts to enforce Event policies.

In consideration of my / my child's participation in the Event and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is acknowledged, **I hereby WAIVE ANY AND ALL CLAIMS** against ScotDance Canada, its directors, agents, employees, executive members, volunteers, and organizers of the Event (the "Releasees"), which I now have, or hereafter may have against the Releasees. In particular, but without limiting the foregoing, **I agree to release the Releasees from ANY AND ALL LIABILITY** for any loss, damage, injury, or expense I / my child may incur as a result of my / my child's participation in or attendance at the Event. **I agree to indemnify and hold harmless the Releasees from ANY LOSS, DAMAGE, INJURY OR EXPENSE, including legal costs**, that the Releasees may incur due to my / my child's participation in or attendance at the Event, whether caused by the negligence of the Releasees or otherwise, and whether caused to my child or otherwise. I understand that the Releasees will photograph and otherwise record the Event, its participants, and attendees. **I consent to and authorize such recording. I further consent to and authorize** the Releasees to publish my/my child's image, likeness and information in any medium, including but not limited to photographs, videos, DVDs, and webcasts. I understand that this publication will take place in the public domain, including in printed materials, public announcements, and on the internet.

I specifically consent to the public release of the following information: 1. Name; 2. City, Province, Country of Residence; 3. Tartan; 4. Age; 5. Results.

I acknowledge that by signing and submitting this entry, electronically or otherwise, that I have read this agreement carefully and fully understand it and agree to all of the above terms and conditions.

ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY RELATING TO CORONAVIRUS/COVID-19 TO BE CONFIRMED WITH ONLINE ENTRY

This waiver & declaration must be completed prior to or upon visiting the Tournament Capital Centre and before participating in any activity.

The novel coronavirus, COVID-19 has been declared a worldwide pandemic by the World Health Organization. COVID-19 is extremely contagious and is known to spread mainly by contact from person to person. Consequently, local, provincial and federal governmental authorities recommend various measures and prohibit a variety of behaviors, in order to reduce the spread of the virus.

The Interior Highland Dance Association of BC (IHDA) and ScotDance Canada and its members commit themselves to comply with the requirements and recommendations of National, Provincial and Local Public health and other governmental authorities, and to put in place and adopt all necessary measures to that effect. However, the Interior Highland Dance Association of BC and ScotDance Canada cannot guarantee that you (or your child, if participant is a minor/ or the person you are the legal guardian of) will not become infected with COVID-19. Further, attending the Activities could increase your (or your child, if participant is a minor/ or the person you are the legal guardian of) risk of contracting COVID-19, despite all preventative measures put in place.

By signing this document,

I acknowledge the highly contagious nature of COVID-19 and I voluntarily assume the risk that I (or my child, if participant is a minor/ or the person I am the legal guardian of) could be exposed or infected by COVID-19 by participating in the IHDA/ScotDance Canada's activities. Being exposed or infected by COVID-19 may particularly lead to injuries, diseases, or other illnesses.

I declare that I (or my child, if participant is a minor/ or the person I am the legal guardian of) am participating voluntarily in the IHDA/ScotDance Canada's activities.

I declare that neither I (or my child, if participant is a minor/ or the person I am the legal guardian of) nor anyone in my household, have experienced in the last 14 days prior to the date the IHDA Fall Competition, November 6 and 7, 2021, cold or flu-like symptoms (including fever, cough, sore throat, respiratory illness, difficulty breathing) and have not travelled to or had a layover in any country outside of Canada.

I declare that neither I (or my child, if participant is a minor/ or the person I am the legal guardian of) have tested positive for COVID-19, and have not yet been cleared to discontinue isolation in accordance with applicable criteria communicated by public health officials (awaiting results); have been in close contact with a person who, to my knowledge, had symptoms of COVID-19 or has tested positive for COVID-19, and have not yet been cleared to discontinue isolation in accordance with applicable criteria communicated by public health officials; or am currently subject to a quarantine or self-isolation order.

If I (or my child, if participant is a minor/ or the person I am the legal guardian of) experience, or if anyone in my household experiences any cold or flu-like symptoms after submitting this declaration, I (or my child, if participant is a minor/ or the person I am the legal guardian of) will not attend any of the IHDA/ScotDance Canada's activities, programs or services until at least 14 days have passed since those symptoms were last experienced.

I (or my child, if participant is a minor/ or the person I am the legal guardian of) agree to the requirements and recommendations of National, Provincial and Local Public Health and other governmental authorities and to those special safety regulations put in place by the IHDA/ScotDance Canada as it pertains the Covid-19 Coronavirus and to adopt all necessary measures to those effects.

I (or my child, if participant is a minor/ or the person I am the legal guardian of) agree that, by filling out and signing this waiver and agreeing to the terms and conditions set out in it, I am giving up my legal rights to sue the IHDA/ScotDance Canada and its officers and directors, in the event that I (or my child, if participant is a minor/ or the person I am the legal guardian of), contracts the Covid-19 Coronavirus.

This document will remain in effect until the IHDA/ScotDance Canada, as per the direction of the National, Provincial and Local Public health and other governmental authorities, determines that the acknowledgments in this declaration are no longer required.

This document is in addition to and does not replace all other IHDA/ScotDance Canada waivers.
