#### **General Competition Rules & Regulations**

EHDA Closed Highland Competition will be held on Saturday, January 22, 2022 at the Beaumont Community Centre, 5204-50 Avenue in Beaumont.

1. This is a closed competition. All competitors must reside north of the following boundary:

Starting at Huy #884, west on Huy #9 to Huy #56, then continuing west on that same roadway, shown as Huy #27 from Huy #56 to Huy #21, then continuing west as Huy #582 to Huy #22. The roadway stops at Huy #22 but the boundary will continue west to the Red Deer River and on to the B.C. bounder. Incorporated towns, villages, etc. divided by these roadways will not be included. (NOTE: This is the southerm most boundary designated by AHDA for the Red Deer Region Highland Dancing Association.)

2. Competitors are governed by the rules and regulations of R.S.O.B.H.D.

- 3. Entries will be divided into categories after the closing date. The Competition Committee reserves the right to combine, split, or delete/cancel classes or events at their discretion.
- 4. The competitors age will be taken as of the competition date.
- 5. All competitors must present their current **2022 RSOBHD** registration Cards to receive awards and must remain in costume for all award presentations.
- 6. Competitors dance in inverse order of entry. Any competitor not on hand when his/her event is called will forfeit his/her entry in that event.
- 7. Prize money for Premier 16 years & over to be determined and are subject to entries received. Medal Structure for all classes: as follows: 1/2 the number of dancers to a maximum of 6 medals for each dance; for an odd number of dancers in a class, the number of medals is rounded up to the next whole number.
- 8. No one other than the Competition Committee shall communicate with the judges.
- 9. Pre-Premier status changes must be reported to the Competition Secretary at EHDA.compsec@gmail.com on or before January 16, 2022.
- 10. Perpetual trophies are the property of E.H.D.A. and must be returned eleven months after the competition. Winners are responsible for name engraving and care of the trophy. Repairs, other than normal use, will be your responsibility. Any damage should be reported to the competition committee.
- 11. Protests must be in writing, signed and handed to the Competition Committee before the end of the competition with a \$25.00 fee. This fee is refundable if the protest is sustained.
- 12. All fees are non-refundable.
