- 5. All competitors must be registered with the RSOBHD or RSOBHD subsidiary body (such as ScotDance Canada) in order to compete. All competitors must present current RSOBHD registration card prior to receiving awards.

- 7. There will be **NO ENTRY FEE REFUNDS** for any reason.

- 9. Dancers will compete in inverse order of entry. First to enter is last to dance.
- 10. Competitors must be on hand when their event is called, or they forfeit their right to dance in the event.
- 11. All competitors must remain in costume for award presentations.
- 12. Dancers must be dressed appropriately at all times.
- 13. Protests must be made in writing, signed and submitted to the Organizer by the end of the competition day and must be accompanied by a \$35.00 fee, refundable, if sustained.
