This can be downloaded at the Apple App Store, Google Play Store or by visiting scotdance.app from your internet browser.

WESTERN CANADA OPEN CHAMPIONSHP AND IHDA PRE-PREMIER COMPETITION RULES AND REGULATIONS:

- 1. All dancing events are governed by the rules and regulations of the Royal Scottish Official Board of Highland Dancing (RSOBHD) and ScotDance Canada.
- This event may be cancelled at any time up to, and including on or during the date of competition, dependent upon public health concerns.
- 3. Age is determined as of the day of each event.
- Dancers will dance in reverse order of receipt of entry (first to enter, last to dance) in all events except Championship. Championship order of dance will be determined by computer draw.
- 5. Committee reserves the right to combine or split classes.
- Age classes will be determined upon receipt of entries for all dance events except Championship, which will be the classes listed on the entry. Should there not be sufficient entries for a Championship class, classes will be combined.
- 7. The decision of the judge(s) is final.
- 8. Protests must be made in writing, signed and submitted to the competition secretary by the end of the competition day and must be accompanied by a \$30.00 fee, refundable if sustained.
- 9. Absolutely **NO** late entries will be accepted.
- Absolutely <u>NO</u> telephone, email, mail or hand delivered entries will be accepted.
- 11. There will be **NO** entry fee refunds. If admittance to the event is refused based upon good health declaration, fees will be refunded except for an administration fee of \$5.00 per family.
- Championship: Computer draws for each dance. All dancers must dance the 2024 Championship steps set forth by the RSOBHD.
- 13. **Pre-Championship:** Entry is restricted to those who have never won a Pre-Championship or a Championship.
- 14. Dancers may enter either Pre-Championship (if eligible, see Rule 13), Championship, or both.
- Premiership: Dancers will dance in reverse order of entry. All dancers must dance the 2024 Premiership steps set forth by the RSOBHD
- 16. Premier National: Open to Premier dancers who do not wish to dance the Premiership. Sailors' Hornpipe is a 4 step for dancers 7 & under 12 years, 5 step for all dancers 12 years and over.

- 17. Dancers must choose between the Premiership and Premier National competition.
- 18. **Choreography Challenge:** Open to Premier & Pre-Premier dancers. One dancer from each Small Group will register for the Choreography Challenge with their online registration. Full name, age, RSOBHD number and name of teacher/school for each member of the Small Group must be included for the entry to be valid. Dance not to exceed 2 minutes including entrance and exit. Music must be emailed to ihda.competitions@gmail.com no later than March 15, 2024 and a backup copy on a usb memory stick must be brought to the event. Choreography must be Scottish or Celtic in appearance and theme including costume. Teams may use props during their performance, either static or nonstatic provided that they do not require setup or takedown, but live animals are not permitted. Choreography stage size will be 24 feet wide by 20 feet deep. Individual dancers may only enter one (1) choreography.
- 19. Dancers filling in for the Reel must dance entire dance.
- All competitors must present current RSOBHD registration card before receiving their awards. Awards will be held, and a \$10.00 fee applied to any dancer without a current RSOBHD card.
- 21. Prizes: Cash prizes awarded in the 16 & over Championship, Premiership and Premier National Competition. Medals for all other classes. Beginner & Novice Special Fling will receive a special prize. Choregraphy Challenge winners will receive a special prize.
- 22. Online entries will be accepted from 8:00 am PST January 15, 2024, through March 15, 2024.
- 23. All category changes must be emailed to ihda.competitions@gmail.com before March 20, 2024.
- 24. Dancers must be dressed appropriately at all times.
- 25. All competitors must remain in costume for award presentations.
- 26. Number will be used for both days.
- 27. Dancers and parents must respect the ScotDance Canada Risk Management Guidelines, Local Health Authority directives, and the RSOBHD Code of Ethics.
