Competition Rules

1. Opening date for entries - All registrations will be done online at www.manitobahighlandgathering.org. Registration opens May 6, 2024 at 8 p.m. Registration closes May 26, 2024 at 11:59 pm. Once entry limit received, no more entries will be accepted. No field entries.
2. Notify Alana Goudie at boomchain@mts.net of any change in classification no later than June 14, 2024.
3. All dancers must present their RSOBHD card at registration in order to compete.
4. Pre-Premier regular events will be a flat rate of \$35.00. Premier events will be a flat rate of \$45.00. All Solo Choreography will be \$12.00 and all Duet Choreography will be \$20.00. A provincial surcharge of \$1.00 and online transaction fee of \$3.50 will be applied per entry.
5. Dancers must be in suitable costume to receive an award.
6. Judges decisions are final. Objections can be made in writing, accompanied by a \$25.00 handling fee, to the dance coordinator within 30 minutes of the event.
7. All dancing events are governed by RSOBHD rules.
8. First to enter, last to dance. Dancers not present when their class is called will only be permitted to dance out of order at the discretion of the adjudicator.
9. Prize money, if desired will be awarded in lieu of medals for Premier dancers aged 16 years or older: \$50, \$35, \$25, \$15, \$10, \$5. Trophies will be awarded in all classes, except primary.
10. All Pre-Premier awards will be presented following the morning events. All Choreography awards will be presented immediately afterwards. All Premier awards will be presented following the afternoon events.
11. The competition committee reserves the right to combine, divide or delete classes, depending on entries. We also reserve the right to cancel the event at our discretion. In the event of cancellation, refunds will be provided.
12. Technical Advisor – Gaelyn McGregor
13. Refunds with medical certificate only.
14. Demonstration Pas-de-Basques: No entry fees, cannot enter any other event. All dancers receive a gift. Please submit an entry to determine numbers.
15. Special Events –: Open to all Pre-Premier and Premier Dancers. Duet Choreography Dancers enter as a team. Names and ages of both dancers must appear on the entry form. Dancers may enter one solo and one duet choreography event. Complete dance with entrance and exit may not exceed 3 minutes. Music must be provided to registration desk upon registering at 12:30 p.m.

WAIVER: *I am aware that participating in the Manitoba Highland Gathering (the "Event") involves the potential for risks, dangers and hazards, including but not limited to: (a) injury to myself / my child as a result of the physical nature of dance competition and performance; and (b) the taking and/or release of unauthorized photographs, video and/or other recordings of myself and/or my child, notwithstanding efforts to enforce Event policies.*

In consideration of my / my child's participation in the Event and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is acknowledged, I hereby WAIVE ANY AND ALL CLAIMS against ScotDance Canada, its directors, agents, employees, executive members, volunteers and organizers of the Event (the "Releasees"), which I now have, or hereafter may have against the Releasees. In particular, but without limiting the foregoing, I agree to release the Releasees from ANY AND ALL LIABILITY for any loss, damage, injury, or expense I / my child may incur as a result of my / my child's participation in or attendance at the Event. I agree to indemnify and hold harmless the Releasees from ANY LOSS, DAMAGE, INJURY OR EXPENSE, including legal costs, that the Releasees may incur due to my / my child's participation in or attendance at the Event, whether caused by the negligence of the Releasees or otherwise, and whether caused to my child or otherwise. I understand that the Releasees will photograph and otherwise record the Event, its participants and attendees. I consent to and authorize such recording. I further consent to and authorize the Releasees to publish my/my child's image, likeness and information in any medium, including but not limited to photographs, videos, DVDs, and web-casts. I understand that this publication will take place in the public domain, including in printed materials, public announcements, and on the internet.

I acknowledge that by signing and submitting this entry, electronically or otherwise, that I have read this agreement carefully and fully understand it, and agree to all of the above terms and conditions.
