# **Competition Rules and Regulations:**

Awards

1. All dancing events are governed by the rules and regulations of the Royal Scottish Official Board of Highland Dancing (RSOBHD) and ScotDance Canada.

- 2. This event may be cancelled at any time up to, and including on or during the date of competition, dependent upon public health concerns.
- 3. The decision of the judge(s) is final.
- 4. Dancers will compete in reverse order of entry. First to enter is last to dance.
- 5. Age is as of 12.01am on competition date.
- 6. Entry fee must accompany entry.
- 7. Late entries will NOT be accepted.
- 8. Refunds are at discretion of Organiser policy (excepting an administration fee of \$3.00 per family).
- 9. All dancers must present their 2024 dance card at registration. A \$10 fee will be charged for forgotten or lost cards.
- 10. All competitors must present current RSOBHD registration card prior to receiving awards.
- 11. Protests must be made in writing, signed and submitted to the Organiser by the end of the competition day and must be accompanied by a \$35.00 fee, refundable, if sustained.
- 12. The Organiser reserves the right to combine or split classes.
- 13. Competitors must be on hand when their event is called or forfeit entry in that dance.
- 14. All competitors must remain in costume for award presentations.
- 15. Dancers must be dressed appropriately at all times.
- 16. Dancers are required to fill in for the reel, if required, based on their number of entry.
- 17. Prizes
  - A minimum of half the number of dancers dancing, to a maximum of six placings.
  - The RSOBHD scoring system will be used for aggregate awards: 137, 91, 71, 53, 37, 23. No aggregate awards will be presented for Primary.
  - Premier 16 & Over Prizes: 1<sup>st</sup>- \$25, 2<sup>nd</sup>- \$20, 3<sup>rd</sup>- \$15, 4<sup>th</sup>- \$10, 5<sup>th-</sup> \$10, 6<sup>th</sup>- \$10
- 18. Dancers and parents must respect the ScotDance Canada Risk Management Guidelines, local health authority directives, and RSOBHD Code of Ethics.
- 19. Danny Matheson Memorial Trophy is awarded to the RHDA Premier dancer of the day with the highest aggregate points over all dances (except special dances). Age groups must have a minimum of 6 competitors on the day of competition in order to be eligible for an overall trophy. As per RSOBHD rules, if there are less than 6 competitors in any individual dance then points gained in that dance will not be included in the total aggregate points for the overall award.
- 20. Joanne Sinclair Memorial Trophy is awarded to the youngest Beginner class with the highest aggregate points over all dances (except special dances). Age groups must have a minimum of 6 competitors on the day of competition in order to be eligible for an overall trophy. As per RSOBHD rules, if there are less than 6 competitors in any individual dance then points gained in that dance will not be included in the total aggregate points for the overall award.
- 21. Small Group Choreography Rules Open to all dancers (Pre-Premier and Premier):
  - Each choreography must list the names of all teachers/studios.
  - Judges who have students participating in team/joint choreographies must abide by the 3 month teaching/judging rules as stipulated in the RSOBHD Constitution and Rules book.

- Small Group is 3 to 7 dancers.
- Choreography: must be Scottish or Celtic in appearance and style including costume and music
- Time Limit: Maximum 3 Minutes
- All dancers must email their music in MP3 or MP4 format to: rhdacompetition@gmail.com by February 27, 2024
- 22. Performance Pas de Basques and Pas de Basques and Highcuts are for performance only. They are open to dancers under 7 years of age, who have not competed previously and are not competing in any of events 1 through 4. There is no charge for this event and no awards will be given.
