The Rules: Please read carefully:

1. All dancing events are governed by the rules and regulations of the Royal Scottish Official Board of Highland Dancing (RSOBHD) and ScotDance Canada.
2. This event may be cancelled at any time up to, and including on or during the date of competition, dependent upon public health concerns.
3. The decision of the judge(s) is final.
4. With the exception of the competition committee, communication with the judges during the event is strictly prohibited.
5. All competitors must be registered with the RSOBHD or RSOBHD subsidiary body (such as ScotDance Canada) in order to compete. All competitors must present current RSOBHD registration card prior to receiving awards. Dancers will be required to pay \$10.00 if they do not present their RSOBHD dance card.
6. **STATUS CHANGES** - Contact our CHDA Registrar via e-mail at. chdaregistrar@gmail.com Deadline for acceptance of status changes is Saturday, May 31st, 2025. No status changes will be accepted the day of the competition.
7. There will be **NO ENTRY FEE REFUNDS** for any reason.
8. The Competition Committee reserves the right to combine, split or delete classes at the close of entries.
9. Dancers will compete in inverse order of entry. First to enter is last to dance.
10. Premier dancers may choose to enter the Premier Challenge or Premier Nationals, NOT both. All Intermediate and Premier dancers are eligible to enter the Jig Challenge.
11. Competitors must be on hand when their event is called, or they forfeit their right to dance in the event.
12. All competitors must remain in costume for award presentations.
13. Dancers must be dressed appropriately at all times.
14. Protests must be made in writing, signed and submitted to the Organiser by the end of the competition day and must be accompanied by a \$35.00 fee, refundable, if sustained.
