General Competition Rules & Regulations

EHDA Open National Competition will be held on Saturday, October 25, 2024 at 6310 Wagner Road NW, Edmonton, Alberta

- Age as of October 25, 2025.
- Entries will be divided into categories after the closing date.
 The Competition Committee reserves the right to combine, split, or delete/cancel classes or events at their discretion.
- All competitors must present their current 2025 RSOBHD registration cards to receive awards and must remain in costume for all award presentations.
- 4. Prize Money to be determined based on entries for Premier 16 years and over. Medal Structure for all classes is 1/2 the number of dancers to a maximum of 6 medals for each dance; for an odd number of dancers in a class, the number of medals is rounded up to the next whole number.
- No one other than the Competition Committee shall communicate with the judges.
- 6. Average age for Choreography will determine age group.

 Dancers may enter both Small (3-5 dancers) and Large (6 or more dancers) Groups. Total time not to exceed 3 minutes for Small group or 5 minutes for Large group. Choreography music must be emailed to: EHDA.compsec@gmail.com by Sunday, October 19, 2025.
- Pre-Premier status changes must be reported prior to Sunday, October 19, 2025, please email: EHDA.compsec@gmail.com
- 6. Perpetual Trophies are the property of EHDA. and must be returned eleven months after the competition. Winners are responsible for name engraving, care of the trophy and replacement in case of loss. Repairs, other than normal maintenance, will be the responsibility of the dancer or parent/guardian. Any damage should be reported to the competition committee well in advance of the next year's event.
- 7. Protest must be in writing, signed and handed to the competition committee before the end of the competition with a \$25.00 fee. This fee is refundable if the protest is sustained.
- 8. All fees are non-refundable.
