Competition Rules: Please read carefully:

- All dancing events are sanctioned by the rules and regulations of the Royal Scottish Official Board of Highland Dancing (RSOBHD) and ScotDance Canada.
- This event may be cancelled at any time up to, and including on or during the date of competition, dependent upon public health concerns.
- The decision of the judge(s) is final. Championship Rules & Regulations Open Competition Rules & Regulations Alberta Highland Dancing Association
- With the exception of the competition committee, communication with the judges during the event is strictly prohibited.
- All competitors must be registered with the RSOBHD or RSOBHD subsidiary body (such as ScotDance Canada) in order to compete. All competitors must present current RSOBHD registration card prior to receiving awards.
- **STATUS CHANGES** - Contact our CHDA Registrar via e-mail at. chdaregistrar@gmail.com
Deadline for acceptance of status changes is Friday, January 16th, 2026. No status changes will be accepted the day of the competition.
- There will be **NO ENTRY FEE REFUNDS** for any reason.
- The Competition Committee reserves the right to combine, split or delete classes at the close of entries.
- Dancers will compete in inverse order of entry. First to enter is last to dance.
- Competitors must be on hand when their event is called, or they forfeit their right to dance in the event.
- All competitors must remain in costume for award presentations.

- Dancers must be dressed appropriately at all times.
- Protests must be made in writing, signed and submitted to the Organizer by the end of the competition day and must be accompanied by a \$35.00 fee, refundable, if sustained.
- Cash prizes for 16+ dancers will be awarded on the competition day.

Workshop Rules

- This workshop is for premier dancers holding a current SOBHD Premier Card as of Jan 24, 2026, and/or a CHDA member who competes in the Premier category as of Jan 24, 2026.
- Intermediate dancers that know the 2026 Championship steps and plan to move up to Premier for the 2026 Championship season will be able to attend the January Workshop. Intermediates that do not know the Championship steps can attend our Pre-Premier Workshop in April.
- Entries received after Friday, January 23, will be placed on a wait-list and considered only if there is a cancellation in the appropriate workshop age group.
- Once registered, cancellation from the workshop must be received by Keltie Wattie via email (keltiewattiept@gmail.com) before 6pm on Saturday, January 24, 2026. For Cancellations later than 6 pm on January 24, 2026, or if dancer does not attend their session, a \$20.00 deposit will be required for any subsequent CHDA workshops.
- Teachers are welcome to observe their students in sessions.
- Confirmation will be by email and times will be confirmed by Friday, January 23. Participants will be divided into classes by age groups (according to birthdates).
