## General Competition Rules & Regulations

- The competition is governed by the rules and regulations of R.S.O.B.H.D.
- Entries will be divided into categories after the closing date. The Competition Committee reserves the right to combine, split, or delete/cancel classes or events at their discretion.
- The competitors age is taken as of the competition date.
- All competitors must **present their current 2026 RSOBHD** registration cards to receive awards and must be in costume to receive awards. (*See page 2*)
- Competitors **dance in inverse order of entry**. Any competitor not on hand when his/her event is called will forfeit his/her entry in that event.
- All fees are non-refundable.
- Competition Prize Money** will be awarded to Premier dancers as follows: 16 yrs & over: 1<sup>st</sup> \$40, 2<sup>nd</sup> \$30, 3<sup>rd</sup> \$20, 4<sup>th</sup> \$10, 5<sup>th</sup> \$10, 6<sup>th</sup> \$10
- Choreography:** Solo must be maximum length of 1 1/2 minutes; Small group (3-6 dancers) must be maximum length of 2 1/2 minutes and large group (7 or more dancers) must be maximum length of 3 minutes. Judges who have students participating in team/joint choreographies must abide by the 3-month teaching/judging rules as stipulated in the RSOBHD Constitution and Rules Book. **Choreography music, in .mps format, must be emailed to rmmckinnon2@gmail.com by Monday June 15, 2026.**
- No one other than the Competition Committee shall communicate with the judges.
- Pre-Premier status changes** must be reported to the Competition Secretary (780) 721-4014 by June 14, 2026. **NO CHANGES** on competition day.
- Perpetual trophies** are the property of the Edmonton Scottish Society.
- Protests must be in writing, signed and given to the Competition Secretary before the end of the competition with a \$25.00 fee. The fee is refundable if the protest is sustained.

All competitors must **present their current 2026 RSOBHD** registration cards.

In order to compete, dancers must be registered with the **RSOBHD** or RSOBHD subsidiary body (such as **ScotDance Canada**). All competitors **must present** their current RSOBHD registration card at the registration table on the day of competition for every competition. Any dancer unable to show a valid registration card will pay a **\$10.00 fee** to the organizer and will forfeit all awards until such time as the card is produced.

If the card is **not produced within 10 days**, their name will be passed on to all Organizers who will be advised **not to accept entries from the dancer or allow them to compete** until such matters are satisfactorily resolved."

The marking room program will not accept special characters, and those entries must be edited to allow the dancer information to upload. Please enter your dancer under the name you wish to be announced only. Age should be numerical only.

**Help avoid unnecessary edits to your entry**
